## START

## THINK

With Rahab being a prostitute, she would have been viewed as a person with a low reputation in the city of Jericho. People would have looked down on her for her occupation. However, God uses Rahab in a significant way to fulfill His purpose of bringing His people into the land that He promised.

- Who are the people in our society that tend to get looked down upon?
- What in your life has made you feel like you don't deserve a second chance?
- When has your past affected your future?

Rahab had the courage to do what was right, even at the risk of her own life. She helped the spies escape and devoted her life to God. God used that and we see that Rahab, the once dirty prostitute, now holds a place in the lineage of Jesus.

- When have you had the courage to do the right thing?
- How can God use you despite your past?
- How have you seen God overcome the impossible in your life or the life of someone else?

"God, give me the courage to do the right thing. Let me know that I am not defined by my past, and that you have a plan for my future that is far better than anything I can imagine."
