PART 2: A Song of Intrigue

START

There are songs we all sing that we might not always understand the lyrics. Nevertheless, we sing those lyrics at the top of our lungs. The same is true for songs written in the Bible. There are often songs that have meaning that aren't understood until later when the mystery is revealed.

- What is a song you enjoy, but don't understand all the lyrics?
- What song have you sung that took on more meaning once you understood what was being sung?

READ

[Psalm 110:1](#) (NIV)

"The LORD says to my lord: "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet."

THINK

The messiah (the anointed one) was promised to come from the lineage of King David. Jesus continually alludes to Himself being the messiah throughout the gospels. Jesus refers to Himself as the one that comes to fulfill God's covenant with His people, and the one to come to make a way for people to enter into the kingdom of God.

- How does Psalm 110:1 point to Jesus?
- What is the significance of Jesus being Lord?

When Jesus quoted Psalm 110, his audience might have not understood the significance of His claim at the time, or even grasp what God was currently doing at that moment. We can be confident that even when we are not sure what God is up to He is continually working to make all things new.

- When have you not grasped the significance of what God was doing in your life?
- What has kept you from allowing God to use you?

PRAY

"God, even when I do not fully understand what you are doing, give me the faith to trust in your plan."

ACT

This week, lean into what God is doing in your life and what He is revealing to you. Allow God to work through your life despite whatever is holding you back.
