PHILIPPIANS 3:1-21

DISCUSS

- God's desire to have a relationship – a partnership – with us is revealed through the covenants he formed over the course of time. How have you experienced God's consistent presence showing up in your life?
- Take a moment and read [Philippians 3:8-9](#). Paul clearly states that righteousness is from God and is tied directly to faith. It is not by following the law or what you do ([Ephesians 2:8-9](#)). In what ways does this challenge your thinking? In what ways does it cause your faith foundation to grow?
- The Apostle Paul highlights in [Philippians 3:13-14](#) that your spiritual journey is about "pursuing" a life that reflects Jesus. How have you grown spiritually over the past year? Celebrate that! In what ways do you want to grow spiritually in 2025?
- **REJECT Legalism:** How has legalism impacted your faith foundation? In what ways has legalism crept into your thinking?
- **REFLECT Jesus:** This week, focus on how you are reflecting Jesus by the thoughts you take captive, the words you say, and how you are putting love into action.

PRAY

Focus your prayer on the extent God has gone to have a relationship with you, and your pursuit to live in obedience to Him.
